Bay Port Colony Property Owners Association, Inc. TENNIS COURT RULES AND REGULATIONS

- 1. Tennis courts are private property for paid-up members and guests.
- 2. Only tennis players and pickleball players are allowed on the courts.
- 3. No pets allowed except for previously approved Service or Support Animals.
- 4. Children under 9 years old must always be attended by a responsible person over 13 years old. The tennis courts are not monitored, and parents assume all risk of permitting their children to use the courts without adult supervision.
- 5. All litter is to be placed in trash containers, lights off when play is finished, and gate is to be closed and locked.
- 6. Courts are open sunrise to 10:00 PM.
- 7. Time limits: Doubles 2 hours Singles 1 ½ hours
- 8. Paid instructors/trainers must be registered with the Association Property Manager, shall have, maintain and provide copies of occupational and professional licenses (if any exist for that activity), and proof of general liability insurance. If an instructor/trainer provides tennis lessons more than any part of two days in any 30 day period, he or she shall designate the Association as an additional insured on their general liability insurance policy and provide coverage of not less than \$300,000.00. Instruction/coaching by a paid instructor/trainer is limited to one (1) hour lessons with no more than two (2) consecutive lessons when all courts are full when other members present are awaiting courts to open. At least one individual of the instructor's class must be a paid-up Association member in good standing. All others must be guests of the member.
- 9. No dangerous activity, acts of nuisance, or trespassing is permitted.
- 10. Rules violations may result in loss of use privileges for a period up to 90 days in addition to fines.
- 11. One access device may be issued to each household in good standing upon payment of a \$15.00 deposit. YOU MUST SEND A CHECK MADE PAYABLE TO BAY PORT COLONY FOR \$15.00, ALONG WITH THE RULES AND REGULATIONS AGREEMENT to Bay Port Colony, 4131 Gunn Highway, Tampa, FL 33618. Access device must be returned upon transfer of membership rights and within 48 hours upon demand from the Board or its representative for rules violations or non-payment of dues or assessments. Failure to return access device will result in forfeiture of deposit and may be cause for issuance of a no trespassing notice. Replacement of lost access device will result in forfeiture of held deposit and a \$100 non-refundable fee. Access devices may not be loaned to anyone or duplicated. Access devices must be returned to the issuing office upon sale of residence.
- 12. The Association is not responsible for injury or lost or damaged personal property.
- 13. The Association may seek damages from those damaging Association properties.
